



Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? "Reducing federal regulations and red tape on small businesses will help businesses grow and create jobs."







2. Those who would reduce federal regulations to increase American energy production in order to create jobs and lower the cost of fuel and electricity.




In order to get the economy growing again, which of the following do you think would be more effective to grow the economy and create jobs?

Methodology

This national survey was conducted among 1,000 likely voters between January 10th and 12th, 2012. All interviews were conducted via telephone by professional interviewers.

Interview selection was random within predetermined election units. These units were structured to correlate with actual voter turnout in a nationwide general election.

This survey of 1,000 likely voters has an accuracy of +/- 3.1% at a 95% confidence interval.
